Brian's Family


I was raised in a very supportive and close family where we always had big family gatherings with relatives to celebrate holidays and birthdays. I am so grateful that we still continue these gatherings today.

Three out of the six grandchildren in our family are adopted. My parents and siblings have served as inspiration and are elated and beyond supportive towards our decision to adopt and start our family story.

















Our Home
