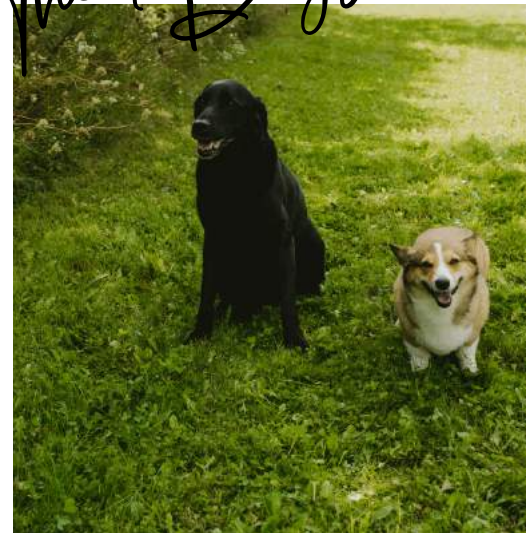
It feels so good to be home
