


We are honored to be a part this child's adoption legacy, that we get to love them and their story. We hope to listen and understand what would honor you in raising this child.

What we do for others is what matters, we teach and prioritize putting each others needs before our own. It creates a compassionate heart, and a encourages deep friendships.


Our Faith






















Our Community

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




